



BRUCE GILES DISTINGUISHED SERVICE AWARD

Background

- NEBB USA presently recognises exemplary service by conferring of the George B. Hightower Distinguished Service Award. This award was established to honour outstanding individuals who have served NEBB with distinction, given their time and talents and proven their dedication to NEBB and the future of this industry through their exemplary service.
- In 2012, the NEBB Australia Committee agreed to the establishment of a Bruce Giles Distinguished Service Award to honour such people who have made such a contribution to the NEBB program in Australia. Prior to introduction the consent of the late Bruce Giles family was sought to use the name.

The Award

The Bruce Giles Distinguished Service Award can be made annually. The award will be conferred at the NEBB Australia annual seminar day. The recipient of the award will receive a framed citation detailing the reasons behind why the award was made to the person concerned.

An honour board will be created and displayed within the NEBB Australia offices.

There will no other ongoing benefits or entitlements given to the recipient.

In June each year NEBB Certified Companies within the NEBB Australia area will be invited to nominate a person for the award. NEBB Australia and Chapter Committee members may nominate a person. Each nomination must be made in writing and on the official Bruce Giles Distinguished Service Award nomination form.

Nominations will close on 30th July of each year.

Eligibility

A wide range of people and/or organisations are eligible to be nominated for the award. They might include but are not limited to: --

- Employees of NEBB Certified companies;
- Consultants to NEBB Australia;

Criteria for award

The overarching consideration in conferring the award is to recognise people that have undertaken activities or provided services which have benefited the NEBB program in Australia and its regions. These people or organisations have: --

- Served on NEBB committees.
- Made a valuable intellectual contribution to NEBB Australia.
- Been responsible for advocating a particular cause or issue.
